Program Basics

As a CSM, you will have the opportunity to grow in your knowledge of different life-skills as you assist our staff and interns. You will have involvement in food service, maintenance, dishwashing, hospitality, program assistance and photo and video capture. Each week, you will have a specific ministry focus which includes a different set of responsibilities. You will also grow in your knowledge of biblical principles specifically geared toward the program through in-depth Bible study, prayer, journaling and small group discussion. Included with this information packet is an application for admission into the CSM program. When a completed application is returned to Bambi Lake, it will be reviewed by camp leadership and considered for acceptance. Three references are also required. Each reference form must be mailed or emailed **separately by your reference** before an application is considered complete. Applicants will receive notification on or before April 1st. Do not go forward in acquiring financial/prayer support unless you have been accepted into the program. Spaces are limited to four males and four females.

Financial Support

Because Bambi Lake views the CSM program as a *short-term missionary opportunity* for its participants. We see this as an opportunity to understand what most missionaries go through on a regular basis. *If accepted into the program*, you will be expected to raise financial support to help compensate your time here. The minimum amount recommended is \$400.⁰⁰ (\$50.00 for each week on camp) This is your money. *This amount covers extra food cost, weekend trips and activities, and gas money to and from home.* This money will be paid back to you as a pay check weekly. Any amount raised above and beyond the minimum expectation can be considered your missionary pay. Once you have been admitted into the program by the CSM Director, you will receive further information regarding specifics about financial support.

Prayer Support

Even more important than financial support, is prayer support! As a CSM you will also need to secure at least ten different couples or individuals who will commit to pray for you throughout the summer camping season. Under the guidance of the CSM Director you will write each of your supporters a letter during the summer to inform them of prayer requests, praises and what you are learning!

Participants in the CSM Program...

- must be committed, born-again Christians who are at least 15 years of age and no older than 18. They should be involved in their local church, must demonstrate some level of spiritual maturity and a desire to grow and serve.
- are considered minors and will be under the direct supervision of Bambi Lake. They will also be under the rules and regulations of Bambi Lake's staff manual and the Michigan State Department of Human Services' guidelines for summer camp staff. Though they are staff and are very vital to the ministry, there are certain regulations specific to minors that must be adhered to. For 18 year old CSM's, a criminal history check must be submitted to Bambi Lake and deemed clear before employment is granted.
- who drive themselves to camp must turn in their keys at the beginning of the Camp week to the CSM Director who will keep them until the end of that camp week. Any CSMs bringing cell phones must turn them in to the CSM Director during active camp times as well. CSMs do not have golf-cart or camp vehicle privileges unless expressly requested by camp management and is only granted on a case by case basis.
- must plan for time when camp is not in session, meals, transportation and full supervision will NOT be provided. CSMs may go home during down times but must be back by the morning of the next camp. CSMs may also have visitors during non camp times. Free time begins after ALL work from the previous camp is finished and CSMs are dismissed by the CSM director, and ends at 8am the morning of the next scheduled camp.
- must attend a **MANDATORY**, all-day orientation (10:00am - 5:00pm) on **Saturday, May 16th**, where they will receive pertinent information regarding their responsibilities for the summer.
- are expected to make a full, 8-week commitment to Bambi Lake (Wednesday evening, June 10th to Tuesday, August 18th). If the full commitment cannot be made due to some sort of extenuating circumstance, contact the CSM Director. CSMs must be actively involved in the program each day; a lack of participation or an unwillingness to fully and correctly complete responsibilities may result in dismissal.



CSM Discipline Policy

Though Bambi Lake does not propose to take the place of a parental figure to its CSMs, we do hold high standards for conduct. We consider our CSMs adults and you will be treated as such. Therefore, it is assumed that there will be tangible consequences for rules not adhered to that do and do not necessarily result in immediate dismissal. In the event a CSM blatantly disregards standard procedure, safety procedure, steals property of the camp, our guests or fellow staff or acts in a way that is harmful to the camp's testimony, the camp reserves the right to immediately dismiss staff. For lesser offences such as insubordination, or failing to take ones duties, actions and responsibilities seriously, or other corrective action deemed necessary by camp management, the following policy will be strictly enforced;

- 1st offense, verbal warning.
- 2nd offense, meeting with the Camp Director and phone-call to parents.
- 3rd offense, dismissal.

CSMs are expected to conduct themselves at all times, both at camp and away from camp, in a way that will be a credit to themselves, the camp, and most of all, to Jesus Christ. Bambi Lake highly discourages staff relationships during camp. No romantic relationships of **any kind** is allowed between CSMs and campers. Alone time with boyfriend or girlfriend visitors will also not be allowed. Violation of these rules will be subject to the above discipline policy.

CSM Myths Dispelled

THE CSM PROGRAM...

...is NOT designed to turn a lump of coal into a diamond. *(In other words, it will not turn you into a mature Christian overnight!)* It **IS** designed to take a rock, chip off the rough edges, and form a good foundation stone for this, or any, ministry.

"...you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit." Ephesians 2:19-22

...is NOT a ticket to hangout time at camp all summer. It **IS** going to be physically, emotionally and spiritually challenging!

...is NOT your badge of authority at Bambi Lake. It **IS** the entrusting of important responsibilities to you as a fellow servant of God.

CSM Myths Dispelled - continued

...is **NOT the solution** to getting all of the “dirty work” done around camp. It **IS** a correct picture of the great importance of every part of ministry and, ultimately, the body of Christ.

“Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe as you hold out the word of life...” Philippians 2:14-16

...is **NOT just a summer job**. It **IS** a short-term missions commitment and an opportunity to become more devoted to Christ through serving Him.

“Each one of you should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides...” 1 Peter 4:10&11

...is **NOT for the half-hearted**. It **IS** for those who are serious about growing spiritually and working hard while worshiping the Lord.
